Universal Waste

Small Quantity Handlers

- Accumulate less than 5,000 kilograms (11,000 lbs) of combined universal waste at any given time.
- All universal waste must be labeled.
- Cannot accumulate for longer than one year. Must maintain records to prove material is not accumulated for more than one year.
- No reporting requirements.
- Not required to keep records of shipments.
- Must inform employees of proper handling and emergency procedures.
- Must contain all releases of universal wastes.

Large Quantity Handlers

- Accumulate greater than 5,000 kilograms of combined universal waste at any given time.
- All universal waste must be labeled.
- Cannot accumulate for longer than one year. Must maintain records to prove material is not accumulated for more than one year.
- Must notify the DEP of activities and obtain an EPA ID# for universal waste.
- Must maintain records of shipments off-site. Retain records on-site for at least three years.
- Must ensure all employees are thoroughly familiar with proper handling and emergency procedures.
- Must contain all releases of universal wastes. Must determine if any material generated from a release is a hazardous waste and manage appropriately.

Labeling Universal Waste

- Universal waste must be labeled either by container or individually.
- Labels must contain at a minimum the following based on Universal Waste Type:
 - "Universal Waste - Battery(ies)"
 - "Universal Waste - Lamps"
 - "Universal Waste - Consumer Electronics"

Transportation of Universal Waste

Universal wastes must be transported in accordance with the US Department of Transportation requirements including packaging, labeling, marking, placarding and shipping papers.
